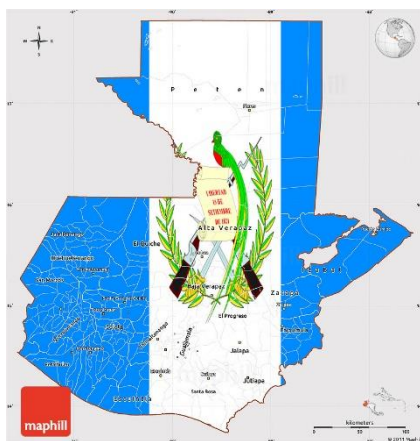


RE-REGISTRATION
